8. Scholarship and Financial Aid

8.1 Overview

- (i) Lovely Professional University strongly believes in the fact that monetary constraints should not be an obstacle for a student to have access to quality education. So, the University extends Scholarship Scheme which is an initiative by the University to cultivate the talent of students that may be hidden due to financial constraints. Scholarship can be availed in all the Programmes of the University, ranging from Diploma to Ph.D.
- (ii) Scholarship Categories: Scholarships are awarded to candidates based on their performance on any of the following categories:
 - LPU's Entrance and Scholarship Test: LPUNEST
 - Certain **National Level Entrance Tests** [CUET, JEE (Mains), NEET, NCHM JEE]
- (iii) Scholarship Brackets: For each category mentioned above, three brackets of Scholarship (Bracket 1, 2 and 3) are defined. Each bracket has its own respective criteria which needs to be met for availing the applicable scholarship. Therefore, the students meeting the requirement of Bracket-

1 gets the highest Scholarship and those in Bracket - 2 or 3 gets relatively lesser scholarship.

(iv) Scholarship Phases: Admissions in LPU are done in different Phases, which are bifurcations of the Admission time period. The amount of Scholarship also depends on the Phase in which the candidate takes admission in the University. Phase-I starts as early as December 2023 and continues till the end of April 2024. The subsequent phases are conducted only if the seats in the concerned programme remain vacant. The amount of Scholarship reduces with each passing phase and no Scholarship is offered in subsequent phases (if conducted). The dates for subsequent phases (if offered) will be updated on the university website (www.lpu.in)

8.3 Details of Scholarship Brackets

Scholarship brackets for various categories as mentioned in point no. 8.1 (ii and iii) is detailed below:

(i) On the basis of Eligibility Qualification:

- Bracket 1 For UG programmes, students scoring more than or equal to 95% marks in eligibility qualification fall in Bracket-1 are thus eligible for Scholarship of 50%,45% and 40% of Programme fee in Phase-I. (For applicable scholarship of each programme, refer programmes and table mentioned in point no. 8.2).
- Bracket 2 For UG programmes, students scoring between 90% to 94.99% marks in eligibility qualification fall in Bracket-2 and are thus eligible for Scholarship of 40%, 35% and 30% of Programme fee in Phase-I. (For applicable scholarship of each programme, refer programmes and table mentioned in point no. 8.2).
- Bracket 3 For UG programmes, students scoring between 80% to 89.99% marks in eligibility qualification fall in Bracket-3 and are thus eligible for Scholarship of 30%, 25% and 20% of Programme fee in Phase-I. (For applicable scholarship of each programme, refer programmes and table mentioned in point no. 8.2).

Note: Scholarship will also be offered on the basis of qualification previous to eligibility qualification.

 For Lateral Entry Programmes - Scholarship will be offered on the basis of eligibility qualification and qualification previous to eligibility qualification. For example, someone seeking admission in B.Tech. (Lateral Entry) can seek scholarship on the basis of Diploma (Eligibility Qualification) or 10th (Qualification previous to Diploma).

(ii) On the basis of LPUNEST:

For each Scholarship bracket, cut-offs are determined by the University and accordingly the Scholarship brackets vary as mentioned in point no. 8.2. To know the tentative cut-off for various programmes and approximate number of students falling in different categories, refer university website www.lpu.in

(iii) On the basis of National Level Entrance Tests:

- Performance in the following National Level Entrance Tests is considered for offering Scholarship in LPU:
 - CUET, JEE (Main), NEET and NCHM JEE
- For every test mentioned above, LPU has determined the cut-offs for various Scholarship brackets. To know the cut-offs for other National Level Tests, please refer university website www.lpu.in

The scholarship mentioned above is for Phase-I only. Subsequent phases of admission will be conducted if seats remain vacant. The scholarship details for these subsequent phases can be referred from the university website www.lpu.in

Important Information

In case an applicant fails to produce the proof of fulfilment of the prescribed eligibility criteria or any other document prescribed by the university or fails to provide original documents for verification by the stipulated date(s), he/ she shall not be considered eligible for admission and/ or scholarship. In any case, if granted due to any reason the same shall be cancelled and the applicant shall have no claim, whatsoever against the university.

- · Can raise the query (if any)

10. How to Apply

Application forms can be obtained and submitted using one of the following methods:

Option I- Online Mode

Visit LPUADMIT (admission.lpu.in) and complete the following steps:

Step 1 : Sign Up

Register on LPUADMIT (admission.lpu.in) with basic details (Name, Email ID, Mobile No., State, Gender, City, Qualification, Discipline).

Step 2: Payment for LPUNEST Kit

The cost of LPUNEST Kit needs to be paid by the applicant as per his/ her choice.

Application Fee:

- Soft copy of LPUNEST Kit ₹ 1000 (for Boys) and ₹ 500 (for Girls).
- Printed LPUNEST Kit of ₹ 1500 (for Boys) and ₹ 1000 (for Girls).
 The payment can be made using Internet Banking/Credit card/ Debit card / UPI.

The payment can be made using Online banking/Credit card/debit card / UPI.

Step 3: General Information and Qualification details

The application form details like aadhar card number, address details and qualification details need to be filled by the applicant.

Step 4: Exam Information

Applicants are required to specify their preferred exam mode (preferred date and time as per their choice) to appear for the LPUNEST exam.

Refer point 11.3 to know the details of Online Slot Booking.

Applicant can also download the hall ticket from the portal.

After qualifying LPUNEST, applicant should opt for a suitable date/time to appear and qualify interview.

Option-II: Offline Mode

LPUNEST Kit may be obtained by the applicant from the University Campus or any other prescribed place by paying cash.

 Cost of Application form of LPUNEST Kit for ₹1000 (for Boys) and ₹500 (for Girls). Once the applicant has obtained the LPUNEST Kit, application form can be submitted by one of the following methods:

a. Manual Application:

Fill the full application form (OMR sheet) after reading all the instructions as specified under the head "Instructions for filling Application Form (OMR sheet)" (applicant must provide 10th grade details and must send a photocopy of their 10th grade certificate along with the OMR sheet) and send it to the university in the self-addressed envelope at the following Address:

Such applicants will not be able to access the LPU Admit. Applicants are hence advised to duly fill the application form and dispatch it along with complete requisite documents in all respects.

b. Semi-Offline Application:

In case applicant is unable to send the hard copy of application form (OMR Sheet), then applicant may scratch the Unique OMR code available on application form(OMR Sheet) and follow the below mentioned steps:

- i. Sign up on LPUADMIT portal (admission.lpu.in)
- When prompted for payment, enter the Unique OMR Code and OMR Sheet No. (given on OMR Sheet).
- After successful submission of LPUNEST application fee, refer the step- 3 of Option I - Online Mode of Point No. 9 as mentioned above.

Note: Printout of the computer-generated application should be retained by the applicant for future reference.

All our correspondence including test centre booking and Hall Ticket details will be through email only. Therefore, the applicants are requested to get ready with valid email id and mobile number for contact. No separate communication will be done for the same.

10.1 Preference for Test Format

We believe in providing flexibility to our candidates, and that includes the format of the entrance test. You have the freedom to select the test format that best aligns with your preferences and circumstances. Here are your options:

Option 1: Remotely Proctored Exam from Home

Take the exam from the comfort of your own home, eliminating the need for travel and offering greater convenience. Candidates opting for remote proctoring must ensure they meet the infrastructure requirements outlined in point no.13.2. We have implemented a secure proctoring system to ensure a fair and reliable testing experience.

Option 2: Test Center Near Your Area

Prefer a traditional test center setting. You can choose to take the exam at a test center located near your area. We have established various test centers across different locations to accommodate your needs.



11. Slot Booking through LPU Admit (For Test Centre Candidates only)

Applicants can book their slot for LPUNEST, download e-hall ticket, can check their result and perform various other activities related to admission using LPU admit portal.

11.1 Username and Password:

Username and Password can be obtained through the following ways:

- a. Apply through LPUADMIT portal (admission.lpu.in) and fill the details like name, email ID and mobile number through which OTP is generated and fill the OTP in LPUADMIT Portal.
- b. Username of the applicant will be his/ her email ID.
- c. Password will be auto-generated. Applicant will receive the password on registered e-mail ID.
- d. Applicant can reset password by login into LPUADMIT Portal.
- e. OTP based login for accessing LPUAdmit Portal is also available on the portal.

11.2 Instructions regarding Username & Password:

- The username and password must be remembered to check the updates related to the test.
- b. The security of your password is totally your responsibility. University will not be held accountable or responsible for any claim or loss that results directly or indirectly from any unauthorized use or misuse of your password.
- c. The Password must be kept confidential. The applicants should not disclose it with others. The Password should not be written down or stored or auto saved on their computers/ device.
- Password is required to book the slot, download hall ticket, check the allocated slot by the university. (If the applicant has opted for the booking of slot by the university)
- e. Once University receives the Application Form, an e-mail regarding Username and Password will also be sent to the applicant. So, applicants are required to fill a valid e-mail ID in the application form.
- By using same user id, an applicant can apply for LPUNEST test of different programmes.

11.3 Online Slot Booking:

While filling the OMR sheet or submitting online application, the applicant is required to opt for slot booking for the test by himself/herself or allowing the university to do the same for him/her.

Flexible Exam Date Selection (For both Test Centre and Remotely Proctored Exam)

To further enhance your convenience, you can either let the university assign an exam date for you or select a date from those available on the LPU portal during the registration process. Option-I: Booking of the slot by the applicant

 Online Slot booking is a web based online scheduling system available at LPU Admit which will be activated as per dates mentioned on the university website www.lpu.in

- b. Applicants can access the LPU Admit Portal to book their test schedule.
- Applicants can opt for their preferred exam mode, either at a test centre or through remote proctoring as per their convenience.
- d. The schedule bookings are done on first-come-first-serve basis and are subject to the availability of seats at the test centre.

Option-II: Booking of the slot by university (For Test Centre Candidates Only)

- Applicant has to specify 5 choices of exam dates on the OMR sheet/ online application.
- b. University will allot any one date (preferably from the given choices) for the exam as per the availability of exam slots. University will process the request for exam slot within 48 hours after receiving the application form. However, all application received before the start date of the slot booking will be processed only when LPU Admit/ Slot Booking will be activated (refer university website www.lpu.in).
- Applicant has to visit LPU Admit and is required to fill username and password to check the allocated slot for the test.
- d. In case of non-availability of the slots out of the 5 choices filled by the applicant or due to any postal delay, university may allot any other date to the applicant.

11.4 Important Points for Online Slot Booking Procedure

- In case of non-availability of the slots in a centre of choice, the applicant may choose to book a slot in an alternate centre.
- b. If for any reason, including poor response of applicants for appearing at a particular centre, a test centre may be cancelled, the applicants who had opted for that centre will be allotted another centre. LPU will inform such applicants individually through registered e-mail ID/ mobile number.
- c. The online slot booking is available only to those eligible applicants who have submitted the application forms complete in all respects on or before the last date mentioned on the university website www.lpu.in
- d. It is the responsibility of the applicant to book their test slot in LPU Admit portal in the given time frame if he/she has chosen that booking of the slot will be done by the applicant in the OMR sheet/ online application form. LPU will not be held accountable for the non-bookings. The application/ entrance test fee will not be refunded under any circumstances for such cases.
- e. The confirmation mail will be automatically sent on the registered email ID after the applicant has booked his/her slot through the online slot Booking interface.

Important Note:

- In the rare and highly unlikely event of a technical failure/ natural calamities/ unforeseen circumstances during the test, the applicant may be required to appear for the test again.
- Applicants must visit www.lpu.in regularly to obtain latest news, information and updates on LPUNEST-2024.



12. Hall Ticket (For Test Centre Candidates Only)

Process for downloading the hall ticket:

1. For Applicants who booked their test slot themselves:

The Hall Ticket will be generated immediately after the applicant books the slot (Scan the QR Code mentioned at page 21).

2. For Applicants whose test slot is booked by the University:

The Hall Ticket will be generated after 48 hrs. of receiving the application form and will be made available at LPU Admit portal. However, all applications received before the start date of the slot booking will be processed only when online booking starts (for details refer university website www.lpu.in).

Applicant can log into LPU Admit Portal to download the hall ticket. The Hall Ticket will indicate the address of the test centre, test date, time allotted to the applicant and regulations. Discrepancies, if any, must be brought to the notice of the university immediately at lpunest@lpu.co.in.

The Hall Ticket will NOT be dispatched to applicants via post or fax.

Applicants should take two print outs of the Hall Ticket using the print option on A4 size paper only. Please ensure that all information on the Hall Ticket is clearly visible on the print out. No applicant will be permitted to appear for the test without a valid hall ticket.

The applicants must not mutilate the Hall Ticket or change any entry made therein after it has been authenticated and received by them. The Hall Ticket is not transferable to any other person. Impersonation is a legally punishable offence.

Candidates should report to the selected test centre with two copies of the hall ticket along with original valid ID proof such as (any one):

- · Permanent driving license
- Passport
- PAN Card
- Aadhar Card
- · Government-issued ID containing photograph and signature

13. Online Entrance Test

13.1 What is Online Entrance Test:

The LPUNEST (Lovely Professional University National Eligibility and Scholarship Test) is a computer-based online test designed to assess the aptitude and knowledge of candidates aspiring to join various programs offered by Lovely Professional University. Whether you choose to take the test at a designated test center or opt for the convenience of a remotely proctored test, the core experience remains the same.

Test Options

LPUNEST offers two test options: test centre-based and remotely proctored. Test center-based tests are conducted at designated examination centers, providing a structured and monitored environment. On the other hand, remotely proctored tests allow you to take the test from the comfort of your own space, provided you have a reliable internet connection and a suitable computer setup.

13.2 Guidelines for Remotely Proctored LPUNEST exam

If the student opts for a remotely proctored exam from home, then he will enter the time and date of the exam in the interface. The candidate will get an email regarding the guidelines, date, and time of the exam. The remotely proctored exam will be monitored live through various Artificial Intelligence tools and by the invigilators. You can take your LPUNEST exam in the comfort of your home while being monitored by our proctors. To appear in exam from home, you need to ensure the following infrastructure at your end:

- The remotely proctored exam required two devices. A Laptop/ Desktop (Primary device) and smartphone (Secondary device).
- A Primary device, Windows/ Linux/ Mac laptop or desktop with proper working webcam and microphones.
- A secondary device, mobile phone (iOS/Android) acting as a 3rd eye.
- Both devices are mandatory to appear in exam. You cannot appear in exam with a single device.
- An isolated room with proper lighting without any external disturbances.
- In case of non-availability of devices, the candidate must opt for Test Centre Based exam.
- To appear for the exam at home, a minimum 1MBPS speed of the internet is required.
- In the exam information step, the candidate has to select a combination of subjects from a given pool of subjects. For example, a B.Tech. aspirant will select one of the options from Maths or Biology apart from the compulsory subjects Physics, English and Chemistry.
- Finally, the candidate will click the Submit button to complete the process.

Note: Once the candidate selects Remotely Proctored Exam from home, then the candidate cannot switch to Test Centre-Based exam.

A detailed list of prohibited activities are available in the general guidelines document. Even an iota of violation of instructions will result in a candidate's disqualification

13.3 Procedure for Test Centre Based Exam

The applicants must ensure that the computer allotted to them is switched on and any problem with the computer should be informed to the invigilator immediately.

The test will consist of multiple choice questions (MCQs) and fill in the blank (wherever applicable). Fill in the blanks will have one answer having numerical value. Each MCQ will consist of a stem which may be in the form of a question or an incomplete statement and four responses labelled A, B, C and D. One of these four responses will be correct or most appropriate answer. Applicants must choose the correct or most appropriate answer by clicking on the button next to the answer.

ROUGH WORK

All rough work should be done in the paper's provided in the Test Centre. Candidate must not carry any paper to the test centre.



14. Question Paper Pattern and Evaluation for LPUNEST-2024

a. Diploma

The test duration is of 90 minutes (1 hr. 30 minutes). English is compulsory and any two of the remaining subjects can be opted.

b. UG Hotel Management

The test duration is of 150 minutes (2 hrs. 30 minutes) and consists of 100 multiple choice questions (MCQ) of the objective type. The approximate distribution of questions and marks per subject is as follows:

15. Regulations at the Test Centre

Applicants are also not permitted to bring calculators, slide rules, electronic watches with facilities of calculators, laptop or palmtop computers, personal stereo systems, walkie-talkie sets, mobile phones, paging devices or any other object/device that is likely to be of unfair assistance.

No applicant will be allowed to go outside the test hall till the completion of the test. Smoking in the test hall is strictly prohibited. Tea, coffee, cold drinks or snacks are also not allowed to be taken into the test hall.

There are no waiting facilities for family and friends at the test centre. Applicants should plan to meet them elsewhere after the test ends.

Applicants shall maintain perfect silence and attend to their questions only. All actions of the applicant in the test hall will be closely monitored using web cameras and closed circuit TV cameras. Any conversation or movement or disturbance in the test hall shall be deemed as misbehavior and if an applicant is found using unfair means or impersonation, their candidature will be cancelled and they will be liable to be debarred from taking examination either permanently or for a specified period to be decided by LPU. LPU reserves the right to withhold the result of such applicants.

18. Result

After the end of the schedule, the scores (subject wise as well as total) obtained by the candidates will be provided to them. The final result sheet containing the ranks of the candidates will be released. These scores will also determine the amount of scholarship one would be availing.

If there arises a case of ties in total scores between candidates, comparison will be made between the subject wise scores obtained by them (details of which will be available on the university website www.lpu.in). Also, the age of the candidates will be taken into consideration to resolve the tie, where candidates who are elder will be ranked prior with regards to other candidates. Since it is an online Computer Based Test (CBT), there is no provision of revaluation of LPUNEST answers.


